### **4. ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE**

John also commented that he has approached Marilee to take over the chairperson position. George commented that John should stay as the chairperson and have other PAC members step in/cover as chairperson when John cannot attend PAC meeting. ### **6. SPECIAL SPEAKER - *Mark Stevens, Area Manager (Tolko)***

Mark Stevens made a power point presentation to update on situation with Tolko – High Level operations. Focusing on the various options to reduce costs, improve quality and value, maintain good safety performance, and improve productivity, and diversifying our markets.

- USA housing forecast is not good so other destinations are being explored and export to the States have been reduced by 15%
- The future of our forest resources are the basis upon which our manufacturing process thrives
- Employee progressiveness and commitment enable us to be successful and Tolko's corporate leadership and investment in equipment and technology capitalizes on the strength of our resources and employees.
- We are fortunate our forests are not affected by the Pine beetle; our forest will continue to provide the basis of our operations.

There was some discussion on the replacement plans for the burner. High Level is reviewing situation and looking at proposal with 3<sup>rd</sup> party and there is a need to have it done by July when the Tolko Board of Directors meet. We

need to get plan in place before December 2008 and per Alberta Environment approval to extend burner operation in the short term.

## **7. OPEN DISCUSSION**

John Unger commented on Marks' presentation and how much the Forest Industry has changed. Sawmills have had to make changes in how we produce and what we produce.

George Friesen commented that markets are unpredictable, but it will change for the better.

Jeremy thanked Mark Stevens for his presentation and let the PAC committee members know that if they have any more questions Jeremy can forward them to Mark.

John thanked Mark for doing the power point presentation for the PAC members.

Jeremy mentioned that DMI forwards their PAC meeting minutes to Tolko is people are interested in reviewing. John said it would be a good idea to share with DMI's public advisory committee to understand any differences and what the committee's experience.
